Grain Guidelines

- You, as a farmer, must make a charitable 'donation' giving up 'dominion and control' of the asset

- After the transfer, The Friends of the Wapsie Valley FFA assumes the cost of storage, transportation and marketing, and bears any risk of loss.

- The farmer should avoid advising the charity as to when to sell the crops, as that may be construed by the IRS as "retaining control."

***You should always consult your legal advisor to determine tax implications prior to donating to the Gift of Grain.*
