Hill Location:

Dry Corn only and beans. Hours will be posted.

Please drive on the scale from off the road. A green arrow pointing up means to the back dump, a green arrow pointing to the left means the enclosed dump. ***PLEASE NOTIFY SCALE OPERATOR WHO GRAIN IS FOR & SPLITS OR FARM/FIELD***

We will have cab cards available for tractors and wagons. CB Channel is 21

All hours will be posted at the scale at both locations and will try and send emails and post on the webpage

Open storage during Harvest is 10 days from 1st day of delivery.

No Early delivery of November or December contracts. We reserve the right to hold off those deliveries if space is an issue.

Grain Trucking is available on a first notice basis. Please notify us at least a day in advance.

Minimum Price, Extended Price, Premium Offer and other Contracts are available, please ask about what we can offer you.
