In accordance with the Code of Iowa, Bremer County has jurisdiction for the maintenance of the Secondary Road system. The application and maintenance of chemicals on crushed rock surfaced roads for the purpose of controlling dust shall be by permit only and subject to the following specifications and conditions.

1. Road chemicals to control dust may be applied by the owners of property adjacent to the road or by the owner's contractor that is on the county's approved contractors list. Cost, application rates, quality of product are between applicant and their contractor. Bremer County does not endorse any product or contractor.
2. Materials approved for use on roads to control dust are Calcium Chloride, Magnesium Chloride, Lignin Sulfonate, and Asphalt Emulsion.
3. The applicant or contractor applying a dust control agent shall **notify the County Engineer's Office 5 days in advance**, so that the roadway may be properly shaped prior to application. **NO DUST CONTROL TO BE PUT DOWN PRIOR TO MAY 19**; a 5 day notice is still required. The county shall not be held responsible if not notified.
4. **Applicants applying Dust Control will mark beginning and end of treated area with 2' x 2' white flags that stand 3' above road surface, and maintain them during the permit period. Maintenance includes keeping flags up and clear of brush and weeds to ensure that they are clearly visible to the blade operators. If not maintained, the county shall not be responsible if bladed.**
5. Applicants applying Asphalt Emulsion as a dust control agent shall erect adequate signs in advance of the treated roadway, as to warn the public that fresh oil is ahead and caution should be exercised. Any and all claims for damages to vehicles as a result of the applied Asphalt Emulsion shall be borne by the applicant and or applicant's contractor applying the Asphalt Emulsion. Asphalt Emulsion dust control areas must be sealed with a cover aggregate.
6. **The County reserves the right to rework the treated areas and maintain them as loose granular surfaces without notice if the permit applicant fails to maintain the treated area in an acceptable condition.** Defects include, but are not limited to, potholes, ruts and rough surfaces that would cause an unsafe surface for vehicular traffic.
7. This **permit will expire October 12, 2018** so the area can be reworked prior to winter. Asphalt emulsion dust control spots will be allowed to carry over to next season **provided** it is free of surface defects as determined by the County and applicant submits a new application for next season's permit.
